- It is to be noted that meeting all the criteria does not guarantee the student will be shortlisted / given an offer
- Applicants who do not have prior experience may also apply. The school will assess applicants based on the selection criteria, which may include the potential of the applicants.

Unprepared Group Task	 Take a part in a brief duologue that is new, then decide how the group wants to perform it together and have a few tries to discuss and improve on it, perhaps with feedback from the assessors.
